Research says unnecessary speed is a major contributory factor in about one-third of all road accidents. Statistics show the main cause of road crashes is a combination of inappropriate speed with some form of human error. In short, speeding is bad driving.

This course on speed and awareness of the possible consequences of speeding is combined with general on road awareness and Advanced Driving Techniques.

Who should attend?

Drivers who have received no further professional driver training since passing their initial test; drivers who are not sure how to recognise speed limits and where they change; drivers who have been prosecuted for speeding and for whom rising insurance costs are a concern; and drivers who are close to being banned as a result of accumulated penalty points.
